It is crucial that the flow of blanks, the starting point for the entire manufacturing process, is managed with utmost quality and speed.

These two criteria are entrenched in the design and manufacture of AMADA's GS II and GX II sheet metal shears.

The rigidity of the frame, as well as the drive and adjustment solutions, ensure an exceptional degree of reliability and safety of use.

Beyond the technical considerations, these machines were developed with an improvement in working conditions, safety, ergonomics and aesthetics in mind.



#### MAIN FEATURES



#### Rigid structure

The fixed chamber provides a consistent gap between the blades, which means that the structure keeps its shape. The door blade is driven by two sets of roller bearings. The 2°-inclination from the upper blade bracket gives the blade the ideal angle of attack.



#### Motorised back gauge

The high-precision back gauge with ball screw moves at 100 mm/s and has a positioning accuracy of 0.1 mm (0.05 mm repeatability).

You can program the crossbeam of the back gauge to retract, avoiding shearing actions that are anything other than precise.



#### **Effective sheet metal clamps**

The clamps use pressure which is proportional to the cutting force; they are equipped with polyurethane pads and apply even pressure to ensure optimum clamping results without marking the product, regardless of the raw material thickness.



#### Easy adjustment

You can easily set the gap between the blades and the cutting angle by using levers on the GS II model. This is automatic on the GX II model based on the stroke width you enter on the keypad. A system of optical viewfinders assists in alignment of the raw material



#### Easy programming

The AMADA keypad was designed with the user in mind. Equipped with a touchscreen, it automatically manages all the cutting para-meters. With a 50-program memory, it avoids all positioning errors by the blade bracket or back gauge. The keypad can be pivoted up to 90° so the operator can see the program sequence.

#### **ACCESSORIES AND OPTIONS**



#### **Ergonomic front workbench**

Designed to help mount the numerous optional accessories such as bracket rails, front brackets with or without micrometric stop.

There are two types of workbench:

- Smooth bench as standard on the GS II
- Beaded bench as standard on the GX II (optional on the GS II)



#### Maintaining the sheet metal and spillway

The machine can be upgraded with an optional pneumatic sheet support or a belted spillway with sheet support and scrap collector.




